

**The Ontario Model Soldier Society presents ON PARADE 2022**  
**Canada's Largest Model Soldier Show**  
**Sunday June 11, 2023 10 am to 3 pm**

Early-bird admission (9 am) is \$10 - for those wishing to get a jump on the vendors' tables.

We will be issuing wristbands and you are welcome to come and go.

**Location - Branch 643, Royal Canadian Legion 110 Jutland Road Toronto**

The Legion is located just west of Islington Avenue a short distance north of the QEW in Etobicoke.

The show will be held in both the club room and main hall of the legion, all at ground level. Enter by the club room entrance which is the one closer to the street.

**Parking**

The Legion's parking lot is on the west side of the building. ***During set-up times (7-9 am) this is reserved for vendor and exhibitor load-in.***

You may also park in the lot of the Islington Village Child Care Centre located immediately to the east of the Legion.

On-street parking is also available along Jutland Road.

**Food and Refreshments**

The Legion will be serving snacks and soft beverages from the bar in the club room. **However since this is a family event no alcoholic beverages will be available.**

Volunteers from the Imperial Order Daughters of the Empire will be providing a food service. This will include muffins in the morning and sandwiches at lunch time.

There are also various food outlets nearby along Islington Ave. and the Queensway.

**Vendor Area**

We will have a full complement of vendor's tables selling a wide variety of hobby merchandise. Space was sold out some time ago. All kinds of toy soldiers will be available from newer releases, vintage figures, connoisseur figure kits and large scale action figures. Books, magazines and more.

Most of the vendors will be in the hall with a couple in the club room. Be sure to check out both rooms.

Shoppers are advised to bring cash, however there is an ATM on site.

## Set-up Times and Load-in

Saturday 6 to 9 pm - We will be setting up the hall. Vendors are welcome to bring their merchandise in at this time once we have had a chance to get the tables set up. Show personnel will be on hand to direct you.

Sunday 7 to 9 am - Vendors and exhibitors with large displays

***The Legion parking area is reserved for unloading during the Load-in times. Bring your stuff in and then move your vehicle before unpacking.***

## W. Britain Company

Ken and Ericka Osen of the William Britain Company and Hudson and Allen Studios will be at the show. They will be displaying some of Britain's latest releases including their new RCMP figures. They will be on hand to chat with collectors.
